WHAT IS LOW VISION?

Low vision is any permanent vision loss which cannot be corrected with medical treatment, surgery, or conventional lenses and interferes with a person’s ability to perform his/her activities of daily living. For example:

- Difficulty reading even with your current glasses or using your computer.
- Challenges with seeing faces, signs and driving.

OUR MISSION:

Founded in 1986 as a non-profit organization, Spectrios Institute empowers children and adults with vision loss, regardless of income, to optimize their visual capabilities and independence through the use of prescriptive tools, technology, rehabilitative training and inspiration. We strive to educate the world to see the potential in every person with vision loss.

THE SPECTRIOS INSTITUTE'S PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Three appointments – an initial appointment of 2½ hours, a follow-up 2-4 weeks later and a 3-month follow-up.
- Discussion with a professional low vision counselor to assess your needs and help you set visual goals.
- An exam by a specially trained low vision doctor lasting over one hour, to carefully evaluate your usable sight and recommend appropriate devices. There are prescriptive magnifiers, high powered reading glasses, telescopic devices and many more options to improve both reading and distance vision.
- Meeting with a vision therapist who provides training on your prescribed devices and education on resources and strategies for reaching your vision goals to maximize your vision.
- Work with an adaptive technology specialist to learn about desktop and portable technologies to assist in your work, school and daily life. This can include CCTV video reading systems, capture to speech devices, and the accessibility available for all types of computers, e-book readers and cell phones.

OTHER PROGRAM SERVICES:

- We sponsor support and learning groups lead by a licensed therapist to assist our patients and their families, held in Wheaton and LaGrange Park.
- We publish quarterly newsletters that provide information on technology, resources and other helpful information.

AFFORDABLE FOR EVERYONE:

- As a non-profit organization – no person who is visually impaired is denied services.
- We are an approved provider and will submit your claim to Medicare/Insurance.
- Depending on your Medicare supplement plan, a substantial portion of the cost is normally covered with exception of the vision refraction.
- If you are covered under a commercial medical plan, we will submit your claim to the carrier
